School Age Child Care



A quality enrichment based afterschool child care program for youth in grades K – 6th. Enthusiastic and well-trained staff provides participants an opportunity to express themselves in activities, including games & sports, fitness, character development, homework help, service-learning, special projects, and much more! Children will receive individualized attention and develop skills in specific areas all before parents pick them up after work.

The program has been adjusted to comply with local, state, and federal requirements regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. The number of children we can accept in the program is limited to comply. In addition, the program is being split into two separate programs: After School Care/Early Out days and No School Days care. By doing this, we hope we can provide care for more families.

AGES: Kindergarten (5 years old)-6th Grade

If you plan to utilize both programs,
you must register for both.

No School Day: 7:15am-5:30pm

NEW pickup and drop off procedures:

The school buses will be dropping the children off at the back side of the facility. This is where we would ask for parents/guardians to pick up their child each day as well. We will continue to have the program specific cell phone for you to call one you are here to pick up your child. Child Care Cell phone number: 218-671-1453. Please put this number in your cell phone.

For No School Days, you would pull up to our side door and give us a call on the cell phone. Staff will meet you. The staff will get your child/ren to where they need to be.

Things to know about the 2021-2022 School Age Child Care Program:

- We are continuing to only offer 5 day weeks this school year. If a week has less than 5 days, that week will be prorated.
- **No School Day Care:** When you register for No School Day Care, you will be charged for all 17 No School Days unless you contact Nicole at least one week in advance.
- **Lunches on No School Days:** Children will still have to bring their own lunches on these days. Please try and send cold lunches as we are unable to use the refrigerator or the microwave.
- **Health Screenings:** Children's temperatures will be checked after they get off the bus each day and questions will be asked how they are feeling. If they have a fever of 99.5° F or higher and/or are experiencing any symptoms, a parent/guardian will be contacted and you will have to come pick up the child.
- **Payments:** Due to the change in drop off/pick up procedures, billing/payment can be done in two ways:
 - You as a parent/guardian log into your Y account and pay the Friday prior to care each week.
 - We set up auto-payments so that each week your payment comes out automatically the Friday prior to care.
 - Program autopayment form must be on file. If you are currently participating in our summer care program, we will continue to take payment out of your account that you have already set up with us.
- **Not coming after school or early out days:** If your child will not be at the YMCA after school or Early out day, please let us know. We will assume that your child will be at the YMCA all week otherwise. Staff will call if they are scheduled and do not show up after all of the buses arrive at the YMCA.
